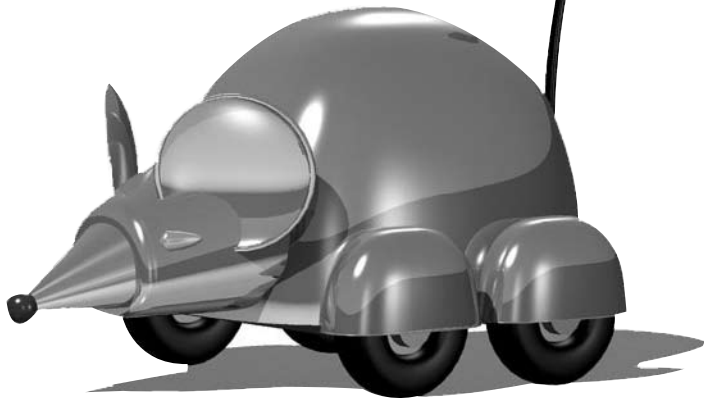

The IEP

- User-friendly. Simple clear screen format. Lots of pull-down menus and pop-up screens – that can also be edited
- Integrated student records and reporting. Eliminate entering information over and over again

The CARE Plan

- For students requiring Intensive Behavioural Intervention with interministerial involvement
- The CARE plan includes what each agency is providing to the student and keeps records of all contacts
- Brief, effective, practical and meets all Ministry guidelines

- Information from the planning page carries over to the progress report page

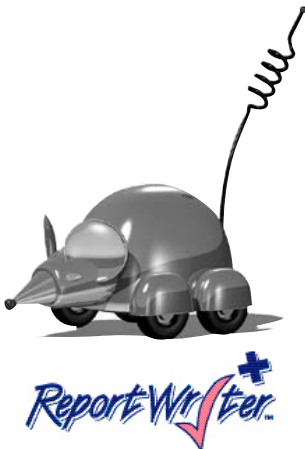
The Learning Assistance Plan

- Pages for testing results, equipment needs, etc. for students who are physically handicapped, visually impaired or hearing impaired
- Adaptive functioning

Questions and Answers

Is the software fee for my students with special needs or for all students in the district?

It is based on the count of all students in the district because that number is more consistent from year to year.



How easy is this to use?

Efficient access to all of the components of the program. Input student information just once and it will appear on all related pages.

What programs do I need to buy?

It's a stand alone program on both Macintosh and Windows platforms. Minimum required operating systems: MAC - OS 8.6 (OS X is recommended), PC - Windows 98.

What if I work at home?

The rights for your district include the right to install on home computers. Working files can be e-mailed between sites.

How will this support my school for a Ministry Audit?

- *Quickly print all requested student records, sorted by category.*
- *Produce a consistent professional looking report for auditors.*
- *District access to files means Ministry reports can quickly be generated for the whole district.*
